- <sup>2</sup> God has not rejected His people whom He foreknew. Or don't you know what the Scripture says in the passage about Elijah—how he pleads with God against Israel?

- <sup>6</sup> Now if by grace, then it is not by works; otherwise grace ceases to be grace.

- <sup>17</sup> for the law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

***Acts 15:11 (AMP)***

- <sup>11</sup> But we believe that we are saved through the grace (the undeserved favor and mercy) of the Lord Jesus, just as they [are].
